

Introduction

The 40th National conference of the Association of Colon and Rectal Surgeons of India was held at the CODISSIA Trade Fair Complex, Coimbatore between 15 and 17th September 2017. The two and half days academic feast included live surgeries on all three days, conference master class, symposia, panel discussions, master videos, oral award paper presentations, poster presentations and award video presentations. The pre-conference workshop which included courses in surgical staplers, stoma care and video recording & editing was conducted on 14th Sep 2017. Both the conference and the pre-conference workshop were well attended and received excellent feedback with exceptional feedback particularly for live surgery workshop. Total 6 CME credit hours from Tamil Nadu Medical Council and 30 credit points from the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, were approved for the event. Faculty More than 100 eminent national and international faculty including Prof. Antonio Lacy (Spain), Prof. Seon-Hahn Kim (Korea), Prof. Devinder Kumar (United Kingdom), Dr. Arun Rojanasakul (Thailand), Dr. William Chen (Taiwan), Dr. C.R. INSTRUCTINAL COURSE ACRSI 2018.

In ACRSI CON 2016 Aurangabad was selected as a venue for the 22nd instructional course to be held in 2018. Zonal CME Report.

1. CME on Common Anorectal Problems

IGIMS Patna, Feb 3, 2018

A CME on Common Anorectal problems was organized under the banner of Association of Colorectal Surgeons of India (ACRSI) at Indira Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sheikhpura, Patna on 3rd Feb 2018.

Objective was to target general Surgeons of Bihar to update and upgrade the knowledge of most commonly done surgical procedures by them. Keeping above objective in our mind we carefully selected topics like Hemorrhoid, Fissures, Fistula, Constipation and Anal incontinence which constitutes a major workload of general surgeons. The Organizers invited experienced speakers who are known national faculties and doing volumes of anorectal

surgeries in their institution. Three of the faculties were office bearers in ACRISI. All topics were planned in such a way to include not only theoretical aspects but also surgical videos and case capsules. We encouraged two way communications between audience and speaker in each scientific session.

This CME was accredited by Bihar Council of Medical registration, Patna for Four credit points.

Total number of Delegates present in CME was 129. All of them were surgical faculties from Medical colleges,



practicing surgeons, senior residents and post graduate students from different regions of Bihar.

There were six scientific sessions; three were pre lunches and three post lunches.

The programme was organized in the Institute's (IGIMS), seminar hall with a sitting capacity of 150 equipped with state of art audio visual facilities.

2.Report- Proctology Live workshop and CME

10th March 2018



Live operative workshop and cme in proctology was conducted by Department of Surgery in association with Maharashtra state chapter of Association of Surgeons of India, Association of Colon and rectal surgeons of India, Mumbai Surgical Society, Colorectal foundation trust, Mumbai on 10th March 2018 at CVTS auditorium. DrParvez Shaikh, DrNiranjan Agrawal, Dr Roy Patankar, DrKushal Mittal, DrJignesh Gandhi, DrRamlalPrajapati, Dr Pravin Gore and Dr Kamal Gupta from Jalandar were the operating faculty.

The workshop was attended by 242 surgeons all over Maharashtra, Gujrat, Karnataka and few from Delhi. DrYuvrajBhosale enlightened all on applied perianal anatomy, followed by DrSatoskar teaching how to do a per rectal examination. The live worktrshop started at 9 am and 17 cases of haemorrhoids, fistula, fissures and pilonidal sinus were operated with conventional, stapling, VAFT, laser and botox methods. The workshop ended at 3pm. Dr Ravi Thapar stressed the applied MRI findings of different perianal pathology. There were 2 symposiums conducted from 330pm to 6 pm, one on haemorrhoids conducted by Dr Sadashiv Chaudhary and another on Fistulae by DrMahadeoGarale. The entire event was well attended and lot of interactive conversations led to educative discussions throughout the day, clarifying the concepts in proctology.
