23rd ACRSI Instructional course 2019, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi

The 23rd ACRSI instructional course was conducted from April 2nd to 5th, 2019 at the auditorium of Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, Delhi. There were a total of 77 registrations from India, Nepal & Bangladesh and



80 international and national faculty members.

The first day had sessions covering some general topics followed by those on surgery of the pelvic floor, rectal prolapse, fissure-in-ano, stomas & haemorrhoids.

The second day had lectures & discussions on inflammatory bowel disease, Obstructive Defaecation Syndrome & pilonidal sinus in the morning. In the post lunch session a panel discussion was organized on the importance of research & research methodology followed by question-answer session. A hands-on cadaveric workshop was held in collaboration with Dept. of GI Surgery, AIIMS & Cadaveric skills workshop at the JPN Apex Trauma Centre, New Delhi.

Day 3 had sessions on faecal incontinence, colonic polyps, rectovaginal fistulae, Inflammatory Bowel

Disease, colonic cancers & ended with an elaborate session covering the entire gamut of surgical procedures for fistula in ano.



Day 4 had sessions on

anal & rectal cancer followed by those on trouble shooting in emergency & difficult operative situations.

The valedictory function was presided over by Prof Arvind Kumar, President ASI. In the evening, there was a talk by Dr Adarsh Chaudhary, a on "Why a surgeon must think" at the India Habitat Centre.

The feedback from those who attended was very positive and they suggested that other courses should be modeled on this one.







We welcome you to this meeting & look forward to interacting with you this November in Mumbai.


