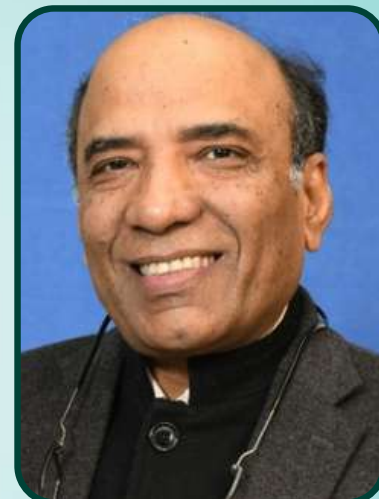
MESSAGE FROM EDITOR - IJCRS

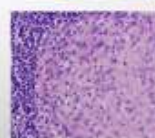
